1964	Urs Baumann entered the business
1972	Langenthal doubled its plant capacity; founded two Sales Offices in the USA
1979	Langenthal built a new Mill in Rural Hall/USA
1985	Acquisition of the Carpet Mill in Melchnau; Acquisition of Orinoka Mills in York/USA
1986	Opening of the Sales Office in Paris
